STATEHOOD COMMITTEE GIVES AWAY 100 000th FACT SHEET

The Northern Territory Statehood Steering Committee has distributed over 100 000 Statehood Fact Sheets to Territorians it was revealed today.

Over 4000 Fact Packs containing initially 25 and now 32 Fact Sheets have been distributed to schools, community organisations and individuals all around the Northern Territory.

“The first ten of our Fact Sheets on Statehood issues, were ready for the 2005 Tennant Creek Show and by this year we published a lot more in response to the most frequently asked question about Statehood.” Committee Co-Chair Sue Bradley said.

“The Committee is fulfilling its brief to inform and educate Territorians about Statehood.

“At our November meeting we discussed our approach to informing Territorians and determined to pursue an even closer collaboration with schools and educational outlets to ensure our material is available to anyone who wants it where they are learning.
