Committee Launches Discussion Paper in Alice Springs Tomorrow

The Statehood Steering Committee's Community Discussion Paper will have its official Central Australia launch in Alice Springs tomorrow evening.

The Paper, entitled ***Constitutional Paths to Statehood***, was released to a forum at Charles Darwin University in Darwin on 10 May and is now being sent out widely to Territorians.

"This paper provides a basis for all Territorians to look at how constitutions work and to make a comment to the Committee about how they want to be governed in the future."

"If you think government can work better, then here is the chance to have a say." Said Sue Bradley in anticipation of local interest in the Launch.

The launch will take place at an informal reception to be held at the Voyages Alice Springs Resort.

Committee Chair Barbara McCarthy and Co-Chair Sue Bradley will speak briefly before distributing copies of this important paper.
